Job Title: Marine Projects Intern Location: Swakopmund, Namibia Reports to: Senior Development Officer

A. Overall Objective

A Marine Projects Intern vacancy has become available, based in Swakopmund, under the marine and coastal programmatic team housed by the Namibia Nature Foundation (NNF). Our goal is to strengthen Namibia's Islands' Marine Protected Area (NIMPA) management to secure populations of biodiversity and marine ecosystem services, further to secure income opportunities for coastal communities, and diversifying livelihood opportunities. We work towards Marine Protected Areas expansion and exploring other effective area-based conservation measures (OECMs) at the national level.

The intern will be responsible for providing technical and administrative support to the marine and coastal programmatic team. High-quality standards must be maintained to uphold the NNF's conservation mandates, by carrying out conservation related duties that will contribute to the overall protection of our marine resources and supporting coastal communities.

B. Results achieved by Key duties and responsibilities:

• Data Management and Analysis:

- o Organize and manage collected data using appropriate software and databases
- o Analyse data to identify trends, patterns, and significant findings
- o Prepare data summaries, reports, and presentations
- o Support the development stakeholder databases and update stakeholders list for all marine projects

- Support the development and delivery of educational materials, presentations, workshops, brochures, websites, and social media content on marine conservation topics
- o Participate in public outreach events and community engagement activities

- o Contribute to project planning, implementation, and evaluation
- o Perform other tasks as assigned
