For years, the people of Nsundwa faced significant challenges in finding a suitable space to gather and collaborate on their conservation efforts. Often, they met under the shade of trees or in the village headman's homestead, where the lack of formal infrastructure limited their ability to discuss pressing issues and share ideas. However, the establishment of community fisheries reserves in the area sparked a significant turning point, transforming their vision for a dedicated office into a beacon of hope.

As one drives through the beautiful scenery of the majestic trees surrounding the new facility, it becomes clear that this is no ordinary building. Constructed from locally sourced materials and adorned with the fingerprints of the women in the community, the office is a beautiful tribute to Nsundwa's rich cultural heritage and abiding commitment to sustainability.

It stood tall as a vibrant hub for conservation initiatives

and community development, brimming with the spirit of collaboration and innovation.

In October 2024, during the Ecofish projectend assessment meeting held in this inspiring venue, elders shared heartfelt stories of resilience while their voices resonated with passion as they expressed visions for a brighter future, where the local ecosystem would be safeguarded and livelihoods supported.



The new office quickly became a sanctuary for open community meetings. Community members now hold regular meetings within its walls, discussing strategies for conservancy efforts and exploring new ideas to promote sustainable development. The building continued to facilitate the exchange of knowledge and inspired an invigorating sense of togetherness, fueling creativity and determination among all who entered.

With profound gratitude, the community reflected on the significant impact of the ECOFISH project. Support from this initiative not only enabled the construction of the office but also empowered them to take ownership of their environment and future. To the community of Nsundwa, this office is more than just poles and mortar; it is a symbol of unity, hope, and the relentless pursuit of a sustainable future. In the embrace of the beautiful Nsundwa landscape, they had built a legacy, one that would shine brightly as a beacon of hope in the heart of the Zambezi Region.
